Minimum CERT Standards for San Diego County CERT Programs

Active Requirements

Must be residents or employed in the community of which they are registered

DSW Application on file (renewed every 2 years)

Code of Conduct on file with the sponsoring agency

Minimum age to be determined by sponsoring agency

1 Continuing Education class per year

1 Exercise per year (or activation)

Additional requirements can be added by sponsoring agency
